

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, FOR THE ELECTION OF ONE COUNCIL MEMBER TO REPRESENT DISTRICT 1, AND ONE COUNCIL MEMBER TO REPRESENT DISTRICT 2, AND BALLOT MEASURES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws in the State of California and the provisions of the Charter of the City of Oceanside, a General Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, to elect Municipal Officers and to submit any authorized ballot measures to the voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside DOES RESOLVE as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California and the provisions of the Charter of the City of Oceanside, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Oceanside, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing one (1) Council Member to represent District 1, and one (1) Council Member to represent District 2.

SECTION 2. That the City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, may also submit to the voters any ballot measure(s) that have been authorized by that body.

SECTION 3. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in the form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. That the San Diego County Registrar of Voters is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. That the polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections

1 Code of the State of California.

2 SECTION 6. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held  
3 and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

4 SECTION 7. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City  
5 Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in  
6 time, form and manner as required by law.
