A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
OCEANSIDE ACCEPTING A FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT
REGARDING THE INSPECTION OF CERTAIN
OCCUPANCIES MANDATED BY CALIFORNIA HEALTH
AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 13146.2 AND 13146.3

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.4 was added in 2018, and
became effective on September 27, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 requires all
fire departments, including the Oceanside Fire Department, that provide fire protection services
to perform annual inspections in every building used as a public or private school, hotel, motel,
lodging house, apartment house, and certain residential care facilities for compliance with
building standards, as provided; and,

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.2 requires all fire
departments, including the Oceanside Fire Department, that provide fire protection services to
report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with Sections 13146.2 and
13146.3; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oceanside intends this Resolution to fulfill
the requirements of the California Health & Safety Code regarding acknowledgment of the
Oceanside Fire Department's compliance with California Health and & Safety Code Sections
13146.2 and 13146.3.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council accepts the 2024 Annual Report required by Health and Safety
Code section 13146.4(a), attached to the February 19, 2025 staff report, which concludes that

1 the compliance rate for the inspections of the 833 identified California Fire Marshal State
2 Mandated inspections was 100% for calendar year 2024.
