A BILL

To amend the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act to prohibit oil and gas leasing in the Southern California Planning Area, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Southern California
- Coast and Ocean Protection Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN THE

- 2 SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA PLANNING AREA.
- 3 Section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act
- 4 (43 U.S.C. 1337) is amended by adding at the end the
- 5 following:
- 6 "(q) Prohibition of Oil and Gas Leasing in the
- 7 Southern California Planning Area.—Notwith-
- 8 standing any other provision of this section or any other
- 9 law, the Secretary may not issue a lease or any other au-
- 10 thorization for the exploration, development, or production
- 11 of oil or natural gas in the Southern California Planning
- 12 Area, as such planning area is described in the document
- 13 entitled '2024–2029 National Outer Continental Shelf Oil
- 14 and Gas Leasing Proposed Final Program', dated Sep-
- 15 tember 2023.".
