The City has an executed agreement with HUD for \$2,248,491 of HOME-ARP grant funds and has been budgeted under the HOME Contingency fund (923479800277.4391). On June 26, 2024, City Council, by its Resolution 24-R0334-1, awarded and appropriated \$1,911,217 of its HOME- ARP funds available for the development of affordable rental housing to Coast Villas (823194723277.5395). The maximum allowed of 15 percent of the HOME-ARP funds in the amount of \$337,274 will be appropriated and used for administrative and planning purposes
