AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE AMENDING OCEANSIDE CITY CODE, CHAPTER 37, TO ESTABLISH WATER SYSTEM BUY-IN FEES

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2015, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 15-OR0480-1 related to establishing water system buy-in fees;

WHEREAS, Section 37.56.1 of the Oceanside City Code established water system buyin fees to be paid as a condition precedent to connection to the City water system;

WHEREAS, water buy-in fees are evaluated periodically to maintain an adequate fee structure to recover costs of improving and upgrading necessary public water transmission, treatment storage and distribution facilities;

WHEREAS, water system buy-in fees have been analyzed and found to be insufficient to pay for the capital costs of constructing public water transmission, treatment, storage and distribution facilities necessary for the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 37.56.1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 37.56.1 Water system buy-in fees.

Effective sixty (60) days after adoption of this ordinance, all new connections to the city's water system shall be assessed a water system buy-in fee based on meter size as follows:

1	These fees shall be indexed to the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index, and			
2	increased each July 1, commencing July 1, 2026, by the percentage change in the index from			
3	the prior year.			
4	SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Oceanside is hereby directed to publish thi			
5	ordinance, or the title hereof as a summary, pursuant to state statute, once within fifteen (15			
6	days after its passage in the San Diego Union Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation			
7	published in the City of Oceanside.			
8	SECTION 3. Severability.			
9	If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance is for any reason held to be			
10	invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision			
11	shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Counci			
12	hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, sentence, clause o			
13	phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsections, sentences			
14	clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
