<b>Comments</b>	<p>Hello, and thanks for reading. My family and I live in the Capistrano neighborhood, and our house flooded in December so we're currently dislocated. Getting the kids to North Terrace school from outside of the neighborhood has been a nightmare some mornings because of the usual base traffic and main gate closure.</p> <p>When there's an accident on the 5 freeway, which seems like a regular occurrence, it's very hard to get in the neighborhood as well. I don't see how in these circumstances emergency vehicles could enter or exit the neighborhood safely or in a timely manner. It would also take parents a long time to get to their child at North Terrace if there was an emergency there or in the area.</p> <p>An alternative entrance would help alleviate this and make it much safer for all of us - not only to avoid the base and stay out of their traffic flow, but to have emergency vehicles enter/exit our neighborhood. If residents have a personal emergency to attend to, we would have a way in and out if traffic is dead stopped on the 5 fwy and harbor Dr.</p> <p>Thanks for your consideration! Lacey Schoennagel</p>
