2 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE  
3 ADOPTING THE *TRANSNET*  
4 LOCAL STREET IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM OF PROJECTS  
5 FOR FISCAL YEARS 2026/27 – 2030/31

6 **WHEREAS**, on November 4, 2004, the voters of San Diego County approved the San  
7 Diego Transportation Improvement Program Ordinance and Expenditure Plan (*TransNet*  
8 Extension Ordinance); and

9  
10 **WHEREAS**, the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance provides that SANDAG, acting as the  
11 Regional Transportation Commission, shall approve on a biennial basis a multi-year program of  
12 projects submitted by local jurisdictions identifying those transportation projects eligible to use  
13 transportation sales tax (*TransNet*) funds; and

14  
15 **WHEREAS**, the City of Oceanside was provided with an estimate of annual *TransNet* local  
16 street improvement revenues for fiscal years 2027 through 2031; and

17  
18 **WHEREAS**, the City of Oceanside has held a noticed public hearing with an agenda item  
19 that clearly identified the proposed amendment prior to approval of the projects by its  
20 authorized legislative body in accordance with Section 5(A) of the *TransNet* Extension  
21 Ordinance and Rule 7 of SANDAG Board Policy No. 31.

22  
23 **NOW THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows:

24  
25 **SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 2(C)(1) of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
26 Oceanside certifies that no more than 30 percent of its cumulative revenues shall be spent on  
27 local street and road maintenance-related projects, or that its expenditures are consistent with  
28 the most recent *TransNet* Extension Ordinance requirements adopted by SANDAG.

1       **SECTION 2.** Pursuant to Section 4(E)(3) of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
2 Oceanside certifies that all new or changed projects, or major reconstruction projects, funded  
3 by *TransNet* revenues shall accommodate travel by pedestrians and bicyclists, and that any  
4 exception to this requirement permitted under the Ordinance and proposed was clearly noticed  
5 as part of the City of Oceanside’s public hearing process for the Amendment.

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7       **SECTION 3.** Pursuant to Section 8 of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
8 Oceanside certifies that the required minimum annual level of local discretionary funds to be  
9 expended for street and road purposes will be met throughout the 5-year period consistent with  
10 the most recent Maintenance of Effort Requirements adopted by SANDAG.

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12       **SECTION 4.** Pursuant to Section 9A of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
13 Oceanside certifies that it will exact \$3,109.88 plus all applicable annual increases, from the  
14 private sector for each newly constructed residential housing unit in that jurisdiction (unless  
15 exempted under the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance,) and shall contribute such exactions to the  
16 Regional Transportation Congestion Improvement Program (RTCIP).

17  
18       **SECTION 5.** Pursuant to Section 13 of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
19 Oceanside certifies that it has established a separate Transportation Improvement Account for  
20 *TransNet* revenues with interest earned expended only for those purposes for which the funds  
21 were allocated.

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23       **SECTION 6.** Pursuant to Section 18 of the *TransNet* Extension Ordinance, the City of  
24 Oceanside certifies that each project of \$250,000 or more will be clearly designated during  
25 construction with *TransNet* project funding identification signs.

1       **SECTION 7.** The City of Oceanside does hereby certify that all applicable provisions of the  
2 *TransNet* Extension Ordinance and SANDAG Board Policy No. 31 have been met.

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4       **SECTION 8.** The City of Oceanside continues to agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and  
5 defend SANDAG, the San Diego County Regional Transportation Commission, and all officers  
6 and employees thereof against all causes of action or claims related to City of Oceanside’s  
7 *TransNet* funded projects.
