Subject: Request for Action Regarding Vehicle Noise and Pedestrian Safety on North Pacific Street

(Submitted by residents of 910 N. Pacific Street, with neighbor support attached)

Dear Mayor Sanchez and Members of the City Council:

We are writing to urgently request City Council action regarding severe vehicle noise and traffic safety hazards along North Pacific Street, particularly from Breakwater Way toward Surf Rider Way. This corridor suffers from vehicles with illegal exhaust systems, excessively loud amplified music, speeding, and repeated stop-sign violations.

These disturbances peak on weekends and summer evenings, significantly disrupting sleep and the quiet enjoyment of our home. This conduct is in direct violation of Oceanside's Noise Control Ordinance (Chapter 38), which prohibits unnecessary and excessive noise detrimental to public health and welfare. Furthermore, vehicles routinely failing to stop at the Breakwater Way and Neptune Street intersections create severe hazards for pedestrians, a danger compounded by electric bicycles traveling against traffic along the Strand.

As homeowners here since 2005, we have watched these conditions deteriorate substantially. Our Ring cameras have captured numerous near-misses, extreme noise events, and accidents (e.g., OPD Report ID 25014675 from Dec. 23, 2025). We strongly agree with the concerns raised by other residents in November 2025 regarding the need for advanced enforcement tools. When bad actors face real financial consequences, compliance improves rapidly.

Accordingly, we respectfully request that the City Council direct staff to take the following actions:

- **Increase Targeted Enforcement:** Deploy police and code enforcement personnel along North Pacific Street during peak violation periods (weekends, holidays, and summer evenings).

- **Evaluate Automated Noise Monitoring:** Study the implementation of electronic noise-monitoring technology and strict fines for illegal exhaust systems, as recently proposed by other residents.
- **Improve Pedestrian Safety:** Review the intersections at Breakwater Way and Neptune Street for immediate traffic-calming and crossing-safety enhancements.

We are happy to provide our Ring video evidence and incident logs to assist the City. Thank you for your prompt attention to this continuing public nuisance and safety threat. We look forward to your guidance on the next steps.

**Subject: Request for Enforcement of Vehicle Noise
Ordinances/Speeding on North Pacific Street
Oceanside, CA 92054**

Dear Code Enforcement Officer:

I am writing to request enforcement action regarding persistent and worsening vehicle noise and speeding affecting the North Pacific Street area in Oceanside, California. The problem consists primarily of excessively loud motorcycles and automobiles with modified, illegal, or unusually loud exhaust systems traveling on North Pacific Street between Breakwater Way and Surfrider Way.

Vehicles, including motorcycles, loud cars and trucks, electric and pedal bicyclists with boom boxes, coming either from the harbor area or the strand area feel the need to “gun” their vehicles going up the incline from Breakwater Way to Surfrider.

Many vehicles glide through the 3-way intersection at Breakwater Way and North Pacific Street going both directions, making pedestrian crossings very unsafe.

This noise and speeding occur repeatedly, most often during the following time periods: Fridays – Sundays during the winter months, and nightly during the summer months, with extremely loud noise during the Friday – Sunday timeframes. The noise is not routine background traffic; it includes revving of engines, rapid acceleration, speeding along North Pacific Street and unusually loud exhaust noise that disturbs not only us, but all the nearby

residents who face North Pacific Street. Many times, it is so loud it sets off car alarms parked along the street.

Oceanside's Noise Control Ordinance, Chapter 38, states that it is unlawful to make or continue any disturbing, excessive, or offensive noise that causes discomfort or annoyance to reasonable persons of normal sensitivity. The ordinance also states that the City's policy is to prohibit unnecessary, excessive, and annoying noises because such noise can be detrimental to public health and welfare.

In this regard, during the summer we must keep our windows shut at night. If we make a phone call many times we have to close windows just to make the call. Some reoccurring times are right after sunset, when people are leaving the beach areas, and then again when the restaurants and bars close near the harbor.

This ongoing vehicle noise materially interferes with the comfortable enjoyment of our home. It disrupts sleep, prevents quiet use of the residence and outdoor areas, and has become noticeably worse over the last several years.

We have owned two west-facing condos in the 910 N. Pacific AEGEA complex since 2005. This noise and speed problem has continued to get worse each year and with the new housing apartments coming to this area, we feel it will get even louder. The recurring nature of the problem suggests a need for targeted enforcement in this area.

In researching this problem, I found that other neighbors came to the City in November of 2025 with the same complaints and discussed electronic monitoring with fines attached. We think that would be the best enforcement for this problem. When people have to pay, the bad action stops quickly once the word is out.

Another big problem is young people and some adults riding their electric bikes along the strand against traffic. Most people cross the street or step into the street based on normal traffic patterns. In one instance we narrowly missed being struck by a young man who was riding his electric bike against traffic. This occurred near Robert's Cottages. Again, enforcement of the traffic rules should apply. Minors doing wheelies on electric bikes is a common site.

Personally, my husband and I have a Ring camera facing North Pacific Street. We have picked up at least two automobile accidents that happened right in front of our building. The camera does contain sound and video. We are happy to provide clips of different incidents. We personally have almost been hit by cars when crossing Pacific Street at Neptune Street in the crosswalk. Also, there are large palm trees at this same corner that make it difficult for cars to see pedestrians wanting to cross.

The vehicles coming across the bridge from north to south on North Pacific Street race across the bridge many times, only to make the stop at Breakwater. We have seen many near misses. I have spoken to a city representative in the past regarding flashing lights for pedestrians at that corner, and the corner on Neptune Street, but were told there were no funds available.

The City also states that the Code Enforcement Division can answer questions about applicable codes and initiate enforcement action. Accordingly, I respectfully request the following:

- Increased enforcement attention on North Pacific Street and The Strand during the hours when violations most commonly occur. (Weekends, Holidays and Late Evenings on Weekends)
- Coordination with appropriate City personnel or law enforcement regarding vehicles with unlawfully loud exhaust systems or who play music above the decibels allowed.
- A case number or written acknowledgment that this complaint has been received.
- Information about any additional documentation that would assist the City, including logs of dates and times, audio or video recordings, or statements from nearby residents.


