

RESOLUTION NO. 26-_____

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, AND OCEANSIDE SMALL CRAFT AND HARBOR DISTRICT BOARD ADOPTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE CITY CLERK

WHEREAS, Oceanside City Code (OCC) section 2.15 and Government Code section 36517 authorize the City Council to set the salary of the City Clerk by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oceanside last adjusted the salary of the City Clerk in 2015 and now desires to make certain modifications to the salary of the City Clerk beginning with Fiscal Year 2026-2027; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk also serves as the Secretary to the Community Development Commission (CDC) and Oceanside Small Craft and Harbor District (Harbor Board) and had at various times received additional compensation of \$100/month pursuant to resolutions of each legislative body; and

WHEREAS, at an undetermined time it appears the City Clerk's additional pay for acting as the Secretary of the CDC and Harbor Board ceased due to an administrative oversight while the City Treasurer continued to receive such pay for acting as the Treasurer for the CDC and Harbor Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, CDC, and Harbor Board jointly desire to reconfirm the City Clerk's additional pay of \$100/month for acting as the CDC Secretary and \$100/month for acting as the Harbor Board Secretary.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside, Community Development Commission, and Oceanside Small Craft and Harbor District Board do resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The salary for the City Clerk is hereby established at two thousand eight hundred and two dollars and forty-nine cents (\$2,802.49) per month. Said salary shall become effective from and after the commencement of the first regular pay period in July 2026.

1 SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall receive additional pay of \$100/month for acting as the CDC
2 Secretary and \$100/month for acting as the Harbor Board Secretary.

3 SECTION 3. Benefits and other compensation in addition to salary shall continue to be in
4 accordance with Resolution No. R95-207.

5 SECTION 4. Provisions of prior resolutions or orders of the City Council in conflict with the
6 provisions contained herein are hereby superseded by the provisions of this resolution.
