A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE APPROVING AND ADOPTING A FORMAL POLICY FOR RESPONDING TO DISRUPTIONS IN TELEPHONIC OR INTERNET SERVICES PROVIDING TWO-WAY REMOTE ACCESS TO CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 707 makes several changes to the Ralph M. Brown Act that are applicable to eligible legislative bodies; and

WHEREAS, among the changes that Senate Bill 707 requires is that the Oceanside City Council begin utilizing two-way remote participation at City Council meetings effective July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the remote participation requirement, Senate Bill 707 requires that eligible legislative bodies adopt a formal policy consistent with Government Code section 54953.4 establishing procedures for responding to disruptions in telephonic or internet services that provide two-way remote public access to City Council meetings;

WHEREAS, the Oceanside City Council maintains a posted catalog of adopted City Council policies and desires to add a required service disruption policy as required by Senate Bill 707.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows:

1. The foregoing recitations are true and correct.
2. The Council Policy titled Disruption of Telephonic or Internet Services During Public Meetings is attached as Exhibit A and is hereby approved and adopted as a Policy of the City Council of the City of Oceanside, to be effective upon commencement of two-way remote participation at City Council meetings on or after July 1, 2026.
