**AMENDMENT 4 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT**

**PROJECT: CITY OF OCEANSIDE SCOUP PROJECT SUPPORT SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT 4 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Amendment"), dated April 15, 2026 for identification purposes, is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF OCEANSIDE, a municipal corporation, hereinafter designated as "CITY", and GHD, hereinafter designated as "CONSULTANT."

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, City and Consultant are the parties to that certain Professional Services Agreement dated April 15, 2026, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement", wherein Consultant agreed to provide certain services to the City as set forth therein;

WHEREAS, CITY and CONTRACTOR desire to amend the Agreement to provide for changes and/or modifications to the Section 1.0, Scope of Work and Section 8.0, Compensation

**AMENDMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, as set forth herein, the parties hereto do mutually agree that the Agreement shall be amended as follows:

1. Section 1.0, **Scope of Work**, is hereby amended to add the following additional work:

**Task 1. Regional Water Quality Control Board Permit Support**

GHD will prepare a permit application for a new 401 Certification from the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB). The permit application will include an application form and attached project description with supporting graphics. The application/project description will leverage information from the expired SCOUP permit and recently approved SCOUP programs (e.g. Encinitas and Del Mar). Based on the City of Encinitas' recent SCOUP permit approval, a 10-year time extension from the permit's current expiration date will be requested under this application. Additionally, modifications to the permit will be proposed to increase the flexibility of sand placement, such as the extension of placement activities into the spring to May 28<sup>th</sup> and the expansion of acceptable grain sizes. Permit fees are not included in this scope of work.

Task 1 Fee – \$8,908

**Task 2. Coastal Commission Permit Support**

GHD will prepare a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) application for submission to the Coastal Commission (CCC). The application will include a completed application form, project description and compiled supporting information. Modifications to this permit will be proposed to increase the flexibility of sand placement, such as the extension of placement activities into the spring to May 28<sup>th</sup> and the expansion of acceptable grain sizes. No permit fees are anticipated. It is assumed the City will prepare the stamped and addressed notification envelopes.

Task 2 Fee – \$8,908

**Task 3. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit Support**

GHD will prepare a letter requesting a time extension to the existing permit, prior to expiration in November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026. GHD will respond to requests for information from the USACE, not to exceed the budgeted amount.

Task 3 Fee – \$5,876

**Task 4. Agency Coordination**

GHD will act as the City’s agent to work towards securing RWQCB, USACE and CCC permits. GHD will frequently coordinate with the agencies under this task in efforts to streamline the approval. Coordination includes responses to requests for addition information, attendance at meetings or local hearings. Coordination efforts not to exceed budgeted amount.

Task 4 Fee – \$16,168

**Total = \$39,860**


2. Section 8, **Compensation**, is hereby amended to add the following language to Section 8: CONSULTANT’s compensation for additional work performed in accordance with this Amendment, shall not exceed \$39,860.00, for a total contract price not to exceed \$359,450.00. Said additional compensation shall be for performing additional professional services as described in Exhibit A (attached).
3. Except as expressly set forth in this Amendment, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

**SIGNATURES**. The individuals executing this Amendment represent and warrant that they have the right, power, legal capacity and authority to enter into and to execute this Amendment on behalf of the respective legal entities of the CONSULTANT and the CITY.


