A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE ESTABLISHING WATER USER RATE AND EXTERNAL WATER PROVIDER CHARGE INCREASES

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2025, the City Council held a public hearing to consider adjusting monthly residential, non-residential water rates and external provider charges; and,

WHEREAS, existing water rates have been analyzed via a cost of service study conducted by Carollo Engineers, and have been found to be insufficient to pay for the costs of improving and upgrading necessary public water transmission, treatment, storage and distribution facilities; and,

WHEREAS, at its April 9, 2024 meeting, Metropolitan Water District's (MWD) Board of Directors established rates for treated and untreated water to be levied against each member agency; and,

WHEREAS, at its June 26, 2025 meeting, the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Water Authority ("Authority") approved increases to the melded supply rate, the melded treatment rate, the transportation rate, the infrastructure access charge, supply reliability charge and treatment capacity charges for calendar year 2026; and,

WHEREAS, Oceanside's water user rates should reflect the cost of providing service including meeting minimal debt service coverage ratios;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows: SECTION 1. Oceanside's Water User Rates for 2026 and 2027 shall be adjusted as follows, effective January 1 of each year. One unit of water is 748 gallons:
