My name is Thea, Founder of Haven of Being, a long-term, trauma-informed shelter designed to support Oceanside's residents, first responders, and local businesses. Haven of Being will provide stable long-term housing, detox-stabilization beds to assist police and first responders, and inclement-weather rooms that reduce strain on emergency services and city resources.

This project directly addresses one of Oceanside's most heavily impacted areas along Carpenter Road. Haven of Being will help clean up a corridor long affected by chronic homelessness, non-operable, abandoned vehicles, and public safety concerns. Our model is built to reduce calls for service, improve neighborhood conditions, and create a safer environment for families, businesses, and pedestrians.

We have the support of numerous residents, community partners, and the Oceanside Police Chief, who recognize the urgent need for a stable, long-term solution that works *with* the city rather than around it.
