

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 OCEANSIDE, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF
4 SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO TO
5 CONSOLIDATE THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH
6 THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
7 TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026, PURSUANT TO SECTION
8 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

9 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oceanside has called a General Municipal
10 Election to be held in the City of Oceanside, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the
11 purpose of electing one (1) Council Member to represent District 1, one (1) Council Member to
12 represent District 2, and for any ballot measure(s) that may be authorized by the City Council;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the
15 Statewide General Election to be held on the same date; that the City precincts, polling places and
16 election officers of the two elections be the same; that the Registrar of Voters canvass the returns
17 of the General Municipal Election; and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only
18 one election.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside DOES RESOLVE as
20 follows:

21 SECTION 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10403 of the Elections Code of
22 the State of California, the Board of Supervisors of San Diego County is hereby requested to
23 consent and agree to the consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the Statewide
24 General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the electing one (1) Council Member to
25 represent District 1, one (1) Council Member to represent District 2, and for any ballot
26 measure(s) that may be authorized by the City Council.

27 SECTION 2. That the election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one
28 election and only one form of ballot shall be used, and that the Registrar of Voters is authorized to
29 canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election at the proper time.

SECTION 3. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the
Registrar of Voters to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

1 SECTION 4. That the City of Oceanside recognizes that additional costs will be incurred
2 by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for its
3 reasonable share of these costs.

4 SECTION 5. That the City agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County, its officers,
5 agents and employees from expense of liability, including reasonable attorneys' fees, as the result
6 of an election contest arising after conduct of this election.

7 SECTION 6. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this
8 resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County.
