A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE ACCEPTING \$39,298 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL TO REDUCE ALCOHOL-RELATED CRIME.

WHEREAS, since 1995, the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) has awarded grants to local law enforcement agencies to develop an effective, comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminating the crime and public nuisance issues associated with problem alcoholic beverage outlets; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Program (ABC GAP) is to afford ABC the ability to work with local law enforcement agencies to develop an effective, comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminate the crime and public nuisance problems associated with alcoholic beverage sales; and

WHEREAS, problematic operations disproportionately contribute to the incidence of drug dealing, public drunkenness, drunk driving, underage drinking, and assaults, which in turn divert scarce police resources away from other public safety priorities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oceanside, through its Police Department, has been awarded \$39,298 in ABC APP grant funds for Fiscal Year 2025–26 to conduct Minor Decoy operations, Shoulder Tap operations, IMPACT inspections, General Enforcement operations, line-up trainings, and community awareness campaigns; and

WHEREAS, the grant will fund overtime for detectives and sergeants, associated fringe benefits, and approved travel costs to ensure effective implementation of enforcement and prevention strategies.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. To accept \$39,298 in grant funds from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control Grant Assistance Program for the purposes outlined herein;

SECTION 2. To approve the grant budget set forth in the staff report under the Fiscal Impact section;
