3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 OCEANSIDE ACCEPTING \$39,298 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM
5 THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC
6 BEVERAGE CONTROL TO REDUCE ALCOHOL-RELATED
7 CRIME.

8 WHEREAS, since 1995, the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage
9 Control (ABC) has awarded grants to local law enforcement agencies to develop an effective,
10 comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminating the crime and public nuisance issues
11 associated with problem alcoholic beverage outlets; and

12 WHEREAS, the mission of the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement Program
13 (ABC GAP) is to afford ABC the ability to work with local law enforcement agencies to
14 develop an effective, comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminate the crime and public
15 nuisance problems associated with alcoholic beverage sales; and

16 WHEREAS, problematic operations disproportionately contribute to the incidence of
17 drug dealing, public drunkenness, drunk driving, underage drinking, and assaults, which in turn
18 divert scarce police resources away from other public safety priorities; and

19 WHEREAS, the City of Oceanside, through its Police Department, has been awarded
20 \$39,298 in ABC APP grant funds for Fiscal Year 2025–26 to conduct Minor Decoy operations,
21 Shoulder Tap operations, IMPACT inspections, General Enforcement operations, line-up
22 trainings, and community awareness campaigns; and

23 WHEREAS, the grant will fund overtime for detectives and sergeants, associated fringe
24 benefits, and approved travel costs to ensure effective implementation of enforcement and
25 prevention strategies.

26 **NOW, THEREFORE,** the City Council of the City of Oceanside does hereby resolve
27 as follows:

28 SECTION 1. To accept \$39,298 in grant funds from the State of California Department
of Alcoholic Beverage Control Grant Assistance Program for the purposes outlined herein;

SECTION 2. To approve the grant budget set forth in the staff report under the
Fiscal Impact section;

1 SECTION 3. To appropriate these funds to the Oceanside Police Department; and

2 SECTION 4. To authorize the City Manager, Police Chief, and/or their designees to
3 sign and execute the grant agreement and all related grant documents.
