A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF OCEANSIDE ADOPTING THE 2025 SANITARY
SEWER MANAGEMENT PLAN PER THE STATEWIDE
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) adopted Order 2006-003-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems (GWDR), in May 2006; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) adopted Order No. R9-2007-0005, WDR for Sewage Collection Agencies in the San Diego Region, which prohibits the discharge of sewage from a sanitary sewer system at any point upstream of a sewage treatment plant and requires additional monitoring and reporting requirements beyond those included in SWRCB Order No. 2006-003-DWQ, in February 2007; and

WHEREAS, the SWRCB amended Order No. 2006-003-DWQ by adopting Order No. WQ 2013-0058-EXEC, which modifies the monitoring and reporting requirements in the original order, in August 2013; and

WHEREAS, the SWRCB adopted the revised waste discharge requirement order No. 2022-0103-DWQ (General Order or WDR) that superseded the previous requirements, in December 2022; and

WHEREAS, all federal and state agencies, municipalities, counties, districts, and other public entities that own or operate sanitary sewer systems greater than one mile in length that collect and/or convey untreated or partially treated wastewater to a publicly owned treatment facility in the State of California and are not otherwise discharging pursuant to their own separate waste discharge requirements or under a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit, are required to comply with the terms of this Order; and;

WHEREAS, the SWRCB's WDR of the Order requires the City to develop and adopt a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) with the purpose of providing proper and efficient management, operation, and maintenance of the City's sanitary sewer system in order to minimize the number and impact of sanitary sewer overflows throughout the State; and

1 WHEREAS, the SSMP shall be updated every five years, must include any significant
2 program changes and be approved at a public meeting by the City Council; and

3 WHEREAS, the City has updated its SSMP, which updated SSMP remains subject to the
4 City Council's review and approval; and

5 WHEREAS, the City's updated SSMP is in compliance with the requirements set forth
6 in the WDR and is ready for adoption and certification; and

7 WHEREAS, the City Council was presented with the updated SSMP at a public meeting
8 on April 8, 2026.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside DOES RESOLVE as
10 follows:

11 SECTION 1. The 2025 Sanitary Sewer Management Plan for the City of Oceanside, a
12 copy of which is available in the City Clerk's office, is hereby adopted and approved.

13 SECTION 2. The Water Utilities Director of the City of Oceanside is hereby authorized
14 and directed to implement the measures included in the Sanitary Sewer Management Plan.
